



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama was under imminent threat and danger from ice, snow, sleet, freezing rain, as well as subfreezing temperatures, and I, Robert Bentley, Governor of State of Alabama, declared a State of Emergency, pursuant to Code of Alabama, §31-9-8 (1975 as amended), for the State of Alabama as a result thereof; and

WHEREAS, at the request of officials at the Alabama Emergency Management Agency and after consultation with other affected parties and entities, it has been determined that a State of Emergency no longer exists in the State of Alabama.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Robert Bentley, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby acknowledge that the State of Emergency, which became effective at 7:00 a.m. on January 6, 2017, shall hereby be terminated effective 12:00 p.m., January 9, 2017.

FURTHER, I hereby declare that the waiver, effective January 6, 2017, pursuant to 49 CFR 390.23, to facilitate a waiver to the U.S. Department of Transportation – Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, including, but not limited to, 49 CFR Section 395 (Hours of Service for Drivers) as it relates to providing emergency or disaster related materials, supplies, goods, and services is hereby terminated.

FURTHER, I do hereby declare that the waiver, effective January 6, 2017, for the purposes of suspending Section 9-17-109(d) of the Code of Alabama and Alabama Administrative Code Section 530-X-2.16(c), in the limited capacity to allow any propane gas dealer servicing the State of Alabama to fill any container belonging to another propane gas dealer which cannot or will not supply a customer, is hereby terminated.

BE IT ORDERED that the appropriate Alabama State agencies are hereby instructed to resume to their normal state of business and day-to-day operations.
